The HPGE program will aim to provide optimal learning environments, where students feel supported and encouraged to achieve excellence in their learning, will ensure that all students including high potential and gifted students have the opportunity to achieve their best.

High potential and gifted education (HPGE) in 2024: All schools have high potential and gifted students and of course that is the case here at Darlington. 
From the P & C
