The Darlington Public School Athletics Carnival is to be held at least 2 weeks prior to the South Sydney Zone Athletics Carnival.

The Darlington Public School Athletics Carnival events will replicate the South Sydney Zone Athletics Carnival.

The events are as follows:

- 8, 9, 10, 11, 12/13 Years 100m
- Junior 200m
- 11y 200m
- Senior 200m
- Junior 800m
- 11y 800m
- Senior 800m
- Junior Long Jump
- 11y Long Jump
- Senior Long Jump
- Junior Shot Put
- 11y Shot Put
- Senior Shot Put
- Open 1500m
- Junior Relays
- Senior Relays

50m and 100m will be heats and finals.

200m will be timed finals with the places decided by times.

Long Jumpers will have 3 jumps each.

Shot Putters will have 3 throws each.

Relay runners will be decided on the day from the fastest times from the 100m.

Athletes who place in the top 3 in the 100m are eligible for selection in the DPS Zone Athletics Team.

In all other events, Athletes that place in the top 2 are eligible for selection in the DPS Zone Athletics Team.

1500 metre times will be submitted to the SSPSSA Athletics convener and the Top 8 overall in Junior, 11s and Senior will qualify for the 1500m at the SSPSSA Zone Athletics Carnival.
